#### **Federation// Association Profile:**

One year after Sydney 2000 Olympic and Paralympic Games, a national multi sports federation of persons with disabilities was created on 1st November, 2001. This federation was recognized by the Rwandan Ministry of Youth, Sports and Culture (MIJESPOC) in that time, and approved as member of Rwanda National Olympic and Sports Committee. In 2007, Recommended by IPC, FERHANDIS changed its name to National Paralympic Committee of Rwanda (NPC Rwanda) in order to comply with IPC's rules and regulations which required all its members to have the word "Paralympic" in their official name.

The National Paralympic Committee of Rwanda is a non-profit making sports organization under the law N°05/1987 from February 18th 1987 having sports and recreation as its mandate. It is a national Non-Governmental organization legally operating in Rwanda granted legal personality No.136/08/2011 under the law N°04/2012 of 12/02/2012 governing the organization and the functioning of national non-governmental organization. It is based at the Amahoro National Stadium in Kigali. The National Paralympic Committee of Rwanda was founded on November 1st 2001 and as has 30 districts Paralympic sport committees and 4 sport associations for persons with disabilities (PWD) as members. It is a member of the International Paralympic Committee (IPC), of the National Olympic and Sportive Committee of Rwanda (CNOSR), member of APC (African Paralympic Committee) and World Para Volley.

Since its creation in 2001, NPC Rwanda has introduced more than twelve sports for persons with disability among which athletics, sitting volleyball, Sit-ball and Beach Sitting Volley Ball, Amputee football, Para powerlifting, wheelchair basketball, wheelchair tennis, Badminton and Para taekwondo for persons with physical disabilities; boccia sport for people with mental/Intellectual disability, goal ball sport, Para judo and athletics for persons with visual impairment while deaf People are playing Volleyball, Basketball, Handball and Football.

using sport as a means of achieving personal well-being, social integration, and economic development for persons with disabilities in Rwanda as well as support their sporting aspirations in the local and international sports arena.
